<p>Deductible <i>The amount you have to pay each year before your plan starts paying for certain medical bills.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pediatric dental services apply to the BlueCHiP Direct medical deductible • Once the deductible is met all pediatric dental services are pad at 50%
<p>Out-of-pocket maximum <i>The maximum amount you might have to pay for health care each year. This does not include your monthly premium.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All pediatric dental services apply to the medical out-of-pocket maximum • Once the medical out-of-pocket maximum is met, all pediatric services are covered at 100%.
<p>Oral exams, cleanings, X-rays (bitewing, panoramic, and individual), fluoride, sealants, and space maintainers</p>	<p>100% coverage</p>
<p>All other covered dental services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic services • Major dental services • Periodontics • Medically necessary orthodontics • Night Guards 	<p>50% coverage after deductible is met</p>
