As part of our ongoing efforts to make high-quality and affordable healthcare available to our members, Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Rhode Island (BCBSRI) regularly reviews the list of drugs that require prior authorization. Our goal is to make sure that our members continue to have access to effective medications at the lowest possible cost.

As a result, effective **July 1, 2020**, BCBSRI will begin requiring prior authorization for an expanded list of drugs that may be covered under our medical benefit for Medicare Advantage plans. You have been identified as someone using one or more of the drugs listed on the back of this letter, which are part of this program. Please note that most of these drugs are typically ones that you receive in your doctor's office or hospital outpatient clinic, and are different from drugs commonly covered by Medicare Part D that you would pick up at your pharmacy. We have notified your provider about this upcoming change.

Prior authorizations will be handled by our pharmacy benefits manager Prime Therapeutics, LLC, who will begin processing requests for prior authorization on **July 1, 2020**. You, your representative, or your provider may make your request for us to authorize or provide coverage for the medical drug you want by contacting Prime Therapeutics, LLC. To request a review, call 1-800-693-6651 (TTY: 711), fax 855-212-8110, hours are 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, or visit www.myprime.com. Send written letters to Prime Therapeutics, Attn: Part B Benefit Requests 2900 Ames Crossing Rd., Eagan, MN 55121. Requests cannot be received by Prime Therapeutics, LLC prior to July 1, 2020.

What should you do?

Please talk with your provider about your treatment options and whether your medications are still right for you. Your doctor may be able to prescribe a different medication, so we encourage you to call and ask if they can discuss this with you over the telephone or make an in-person appointment, once the COVID-19-related restrictions are lifted. Hours: October 1 – March 31, seven days a week, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. April 1 – September 30, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Saturday & Sunday, 8:00 a.m. to noon. You can use our automated answering system outside of these hours.
